» UNDERSTANDING & COMMUNICATING ASPECTS OF MATERIAL CULTURE IN THE MEDITERRANEAN AND BEYOND«.

The material cultures and their relation to the respective cultural heritage in different countries of the Mediterranean and its neighbors are in the focus of the two short conferences. We invite you to reflect on objects and their mediation by means of a contribution, i.e. to explain how cultural heritage can be demonstrated by presenting an emblematic object of cultural heritage. The aim is thus to take a comparative look at the uses and attributions of meanings of such selected objects (e.g. religious objects, everyday objects, works of art). Although, on the one hand, social relations, mentalities and asymmetrical power relations within the German, French, Maghrebian or Egyptian societies are to be included on a meta-level, on the other hand, certain cultural forms of expression and attributions on the basis of the objects are to be taken into account. Thus, the question is how we can understand objects as an expression of cultural heritage in the Euro-Mediterranean context.

Three thematic areas are envisaged

- Teaching: How is material culture taught and communicated? Which objects are considered emblematic of cultural heritage?
- UNESCO cultural heritage: Which material objects related to UNESCO cultural heritage in your country are presented in which form?
- Archaeology and practice: How can knowledge about material cultural heritage - taking examples into account - be passed on to students in an archaeological context and how do museums or institutions of heritage conservation deal with the transmission of material culture?

The conference is embedded in a three-week summer school. At the beginning both workshops will be placed to stimulate an intercultural dialogue. The first part will start in Hildesheim with the participation of the Universities of Munich and Hildesheim and the University of Applied Sciences Holzminden on the German side, as well as Minya in Egypt and the University of Amiens on the other side. The second part will take place in Minia / Egypt. The aim of the workshop is to take a comparative look at the Mediterranean (including the situation in Germany) in order to understand how material culture is mediated and understood in the context of cultural heritage.
