As an introduction to the approaches on conservation and archaeological methods in connection with material culture and cultural heritage, this workshop has an introductory character for the following Summer School. It is intended to focus on the treatment of selected examples of cultural heritage.

In view of the introductory character, a broad focus has been deliberately chosen. In the first section, the focus will be on expressions of asymmetrical power structures in the form of small testimonies of material culture, such as pipes or written and pictorial testimonies, in order to be able to deal with the history of minorities. In the second section, UNESCO World Heritage Sites will be examined in order to address questions such as mediation and valorisation.

The aim is to enter into an exchange on mediation methods and perspectives from a comparative point of view at this international conference.
